Anchor/host Job Description

Overview:

The Anchor (news or sports) hosts KBVR broadcast journalism programs live from our television and radio studios. This person must be a dynamic story teller who has the ability to engage viewers/listeners by telling compelling stories, and not just reading them from a prompter or script.

To obtain this position, a student must first successfully audition for the position and must have either completed or started the Reporter apprenticeship position.

Responsibilities:

- Helps plan and produce news and sports programs by researching and writing stories. Reviews all content before going on air to ensure scripts are accurate and ethical.
- Shows up to the studio at least ONE HOUR before each show begins, or at a time required by the show producer.
- Represents KBVR both on and off the air, and acts with professionalism at all times.
- Ability to process information quickly and communicate facts to viewers in a clear, concise and compelling manner.
- Meets all deadlines for stories assigned by the show producer.
